

The International Investigators Network of Tourism, Cooperation and Development, COODTUR, was created in the School of Tourism and Leisure of the Rovira i Virgili University at the end of 2008.

COODTUR supports the academic tourism, development and investigation projects providing information and becoming a useful diffusion tool. Currently we are 100 members from European and Latin American universities.

In the context of next and 8th anniversary of COODTUR, the coordination encourages both network members and external people to participate in a compilation of photographs and microvideos through Instagram.

This action consists of sharing audiovisual resources of a tourist landscape, understood as manifest and visible image of tourism development.

The purpose of the compilation is to contribute to a better conceptual understanding of landscape and transmit how tourism can be a key tool for development in any of the following categories: cities, protected areas, coastal or living spaces.

1. Recipients

All individuals can participate regardless of age if they are members or not of COODTUR.

In the case of underage participants, the participation implies that they have the consent of parents or legal guardians, who are legally responsible for their publications.

2. Photographs and videos characteristics

Each participant can share videos as many photos as you want, without admitting montages or photographic compositions.

Participants responsible before third parties have obtained the rights to everything image photographed or recorded with full indemnity by the organization are made.

3. How to participate

Participation is by publishing the photograph and / or video on Instagram using the tag #COODTUR and indicating geolocation, a title and a short description until 1 November 2016.

In the case of microvídeos, participants could explain who they are, where they are and the relations between the tourism and that space not exceeding 2 minutes.

4. Uso de los recursos audiovisuales

The organization reserves the right to use the photographs and videos presented for exhibition and promotion, citing the authorship of them.

The photographs and videos collected, if the resolution is right¹, will become part of the audiovisual archive of COODTUR (<http://www.coodtur.org/>), which is connected to [Flickr](#) gallery and [Youtube](#) channel, using *Creative Commons licence* (CC BY-SA 4.0).

The photographs that fit the theme and high quality will be selected for a mobile exhibition, scheduled to open in late November at the Rovira i Virgili University.

Also, depending on the quality and number of photos received, it will be possible to publish a digital or paper publication.

In all these cases, participation in the collection involves the transfer of copyright necessary to carry out these outreach activities.
